### The Right Service at the Right Time - WCB's Occupational Injury Service



Reesa John has a rehabilitation nursing background. She is currently a Health Care Consultant with the WCB of Alberta with over 15 years experience in health program development, program evaluation, improvement and performance monitoring, contract and service provider health care management. Her current emphasis is in the area of health care based disability management initiatives. Reesa will provide an overview of the Occupational Injury Service and how it can benefit employers and workers in Alberta.

### Alberta's Traffic Safety Plan - A Commitment to Reduce Fatalities & Injuries



Jeanette Espie is currently the Executive Director, Office of Traffic Safety with Alberta Transportation. Jeanette attended the University of Alberta and has spent more than 30 years with the Alberta government in a variety of government departments. Currently Jeanette's duties include the implementation of Alberta's Traffic Safety Plan which was released on November 2, 2006. The Traffic Safety Plan is Alberta's commitment to decrease fatalities and serious injuries on Alberta roads.

Joyce McBean-Salvador is the Provincial Coordinator for the Alberta Occupant Restraint Program (AORP). Joyce has worked with various provincial traffic safety organizations and is currently with stakeholders in AORP including Alberta Centre for Injury Control & Research, Alberta Health & Wellness, Alberta Transportation, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Calgary Police Service, Edmonton Police Service, municipal police services, Insurance Bureau of Canada, KIDSAFE Alberta and Alberta Health Services.

Cody McNolty was born in Prince George, B.C. in 1983. Raised in the neighboring town of Fort Fraser, Cody was always known for his ability to reach people.
